ABOUT THE PROJECT

Main objective of partnership is to **develop multidisciplinary joint MSc degree programme SURE: Sustainable Urban Rehabilitation in Europe**, which combines the following areas of sustainable development: broadly understood architecture, urban planning and protection of cultural heritage. These fields will be complemented by social issues, e.g. cultural diversity and mutual understanding of cultures. Universities will be educating new generation of architects who understand need for and objectives of sustainable development, both in terms of architecture and urban planning and in terms of society, as well as protection of heritage. Joint curriculum will take advantage of specific and specialized experience of Partner Universities and non-academic Partners.

First activity to be implemented within the project was ***Needs analysis in terms of the content of curricula in the field of architecture, urban planning, heritage protection and sustainable development***. This activity consisted of the following tasks:

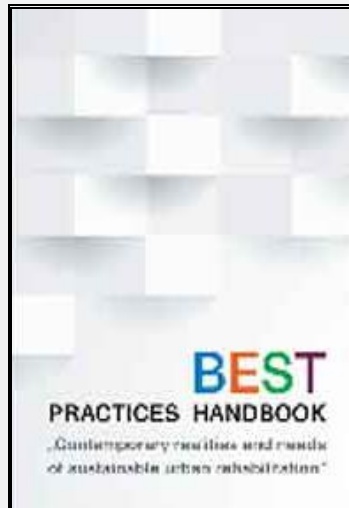
A1.1. Collection and analysis of information about the labour market requirements and practical needs in field of architecture, urban planning and heritage conservation - discussions with representatives of employers and practitioners in order to better attune the joint SURE curriculum to the requirements of labour market and praxis

A1.2. Analysis of curricula (contents, courses, learning outcomes, graduate's profile) in field of architecture, urban planning and conservation of heritage in Poland, Italy, Spain and Lithuania in order to determine the detailed requirements for the multidisciplinary joint SURE curriculum

A1.3 Elaboration of Best practices handbook "Contemporary realities and needs of sustainable urban rehabilitation" presenting the results of analysis conducted, examples of best practice and guidelines for attuning curricula to current requirements of labour market.

OUTPUTS

The works on elaboration of first intellectual output Best Practice Handbook "Contemporary realities and needs of sustainable urban rehabilitation" were completed in March 2017.
