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THE ACT ON REVITALIZATION

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ACT ON REVITALIZATION

In Poland, revitalization gained legal status in 2015.

The Act on Revitalization was implemented by Polish Government on October 9 2015.

Since then:

- All revitalization activities subject to legal regulation,
- Authorities has gained legal instruments of its implementation

ACT ON REVITALIZATION

The Act clarifies issues of:

- Social participation,
- Degraded area,
- Revitalization area,
- Revitalization Programs

SOCIAL PARTICIPATION

Participatory activities:

- Learning the needs and expectations of stakeholders and striving for consistency of planned activities with those needs and expectations,
- Conducting educational and information activities,
- Initiating, enabling and supporting activities aimed at developing dialogue between stakeholders and integration around revitalization,

SOCIAL PARTICIPATION

Participatory activities:

- Ensuring the participation in the process of documents preparation,
- Supporting initiatives,
- Ensuring the opportunity for stakeholders to express themselves

DEGRADED AREA

The area of the commune **in crisis state** due to the concentration of **negative social phenomena**, in particular unemployment, poverty, crime, low education or social capital, as well as insufficient participation in public and cultural life

DEGRADED AREA

- Economic /poor condition of local enterprises/,
- Environmental /exceeding the environmental quality standards, waste posing a threat to human life and health/,
- Spatio-functional /insufficient technical and social infrastructure, lack of access to basic services, low level of transport service, poor quality of public areas/,
- Technical /degradation of buildings/

REVITALIZATION AREA

Area covering all or a part of the degraded area, characterized by a special concentration of negative phenomena, in which the municipality intends to carry out revitalization due to significant importance for local development

REVITALIZATION AREA

The area of revitalization cannot be greater than 20% of the area of the commune and cannot be inhabited by more than 30% of the population of the commune. The area of revitalization can be divided into **sub-areas**, including sub-areas without common boundaries

SPATIAL ORDER

Way of organizing the space which as a result is **harmonious whole** and takes into account all the conditions and functional, socio-economic, environmental, cultural and aesthetic requirements

REQUIREMENTS FOR REVITALIZATION PROGRAMS

The first of the requirements is the **substantive criterion** (checking whether the scope of planned activities is in fact revitalization)

REQUIREMENTS FOR REVITALIZATION PROGRAMS

The second stage of verification is compliance with other applicable documents and legal provisions regarding the area

REQUIREMENTS FOR REVITALIZATION PROGRAMS

The third step is the obvious requirement to provide full documentation

Meeting the requirements determines not only the possibility of implementing the revitalization program but also raising funds for the activities

















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
