


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In the age of Humanism the 'myth' of antiquity became the main aesthetic paradigm. This rebirth is favored by the spread of the press.

In the Renaissance there is a vast diffusion of treatises (L. B. Alberti, P. della Francesca, F. di Giorgio Martini, Filarete)














Piero della Francesca, De Prospectiva Pingendi, 1472.1475




The beauty is in the harmony of Brunelleschi's architecture, obtained by dominating the proportions between the parts.



#### Leon Battista Alberti (1404-1473)

De Pictura 1435

De re aedificatoria, composed between 1443 and 1452 but published in 1485

Balance between Aristotelian and Neoplatonic meanings, Ciceronian rhetoric and contemporary philosophy (Ficino, Cusano)

Concinnitas: absoluta primariaque naturae






Rimini, Tempio Malatestiano
