



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




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Giovan Battista Piranesi (1720-1778)


G. B. Piranesi (*The Magnificence and Architecture of the Romans*, 1761) rejects the concept of immutable beauty and affirms the freedom of critical judgment and the creative role of the artist; concepts that prelude an almost romantic attitude.





The recognition of historical value


At the beginning of the nineteenth century, new conceptual tools of an aesthetic and critical nature allowed us to appreciate every historical period and to evaluate the residual 'artistic' nature of the fragment.




